British Gymnastics Disability Trampoline Competition Structure 2015/2016

In order to be eligible for disability competition, all competitors must have completed and submitted a Disability Gymnastics Classification Certificate. The Disability Gymnastics Classification Certificate lists all eligible impairments.

All other NDP Trampoline competition rules apply unless stated below

Categories used:-

- o Category 1 = Learning Disability
- o Category 2 = Physical or Sensory Disability

Each category will be competing separately with the following groups

- o Category 1 Male
- o Category 1 Female
- o Category 2 Male
- o Category 2 Female

ELITE Disability Routine - SET

- 10 Contact Routine to include a minimum of:
 - o 360 Degree Twist
 - o Two separate body landings, both with 180 degree twist into or out of the move
 - o Moves and shapes CANNOT be repeated

A somersault maybe used to replace each of the body landing requirements.

o Two elements of the set routine will be starred (*) on the tariff sheet and will count toward difficulty marks. These starred elements cannot be repeated in the voluntary.

ELITE Disability Routine - Voluntary

- o 10 Contact Routine
- o Repeated moves will not be credited with tariff
- o Minimum Tariff of 3.0 (if the minimum tariff is not achieved 1.0 marks will be deducted per judge)
- NO MAXIMUM TARIFF LIMIT

NDP Disability 2 Routine - Set

- 10 Contact Routine to include a minimum of:
 - o 360 Degree Twist
 - o Two separate body landings, both with 180 degree twist into or out of the move

NDP Disability 2 Routine - Voluntary

- o 10 Contact Routine
- o Repeated moves will not be credited with tariff
- o NO MAXIMUM TARIFF LIMIT
- o MINIMUM TARIFF OF 0.8

Qualification to ELITE Disability routine

• In order to compete at the ELITE Disability competition a minimum set score of 21.60 (Execution marks only) must be achieved and a minimum voluntary score of 22.40 must be achieved (includes tariff).

NDP Disability 1 Routine - Set

- Any 10 Contact Routine
 - o Repeated moves will not be permitted

Any repeated move will terminate the routine

NDP Disability 1 Routine - Voluntary

- o 10 Contact Routine
- o Repeated moves will not be credited with tariff
- o NO MINIMUM TARIFF
- o MAXIMUM TARIFF OF 1.0
